Cardiac Risk in the Young - CRY, was founded in May 1995 by Alison Cox. For four years the head office was based in a private home but as the charity grew, so did its need for more staff, presentation material, printing equipment and storage facilities. CRY also needed space in which to counsel families and meet people who could help promote and support the work of a new charity.

CRY's Vision 2007: to work with cardiologists and family doctors to promote and protect the cardiac health of our young by establishing good practice and screening facilities devoted to significantly reduce the frequency of young sudden cardiac death throughout the UK.

Medical Aid for Iraqi Children (MAIC) is a British Registered Charity established in 1995 to donate medicines and medical equipment to peadiatric hospitals in Iraq.

Since it's foundation, the value of MAIC's medical aid has totaled **£2.5 million**, spent mostly on cancer drugs and medical equipments distributed to 24 paediatric hospitals in the North, South and Centre of Iraq.

In 2006, MAIC has sent medical shipments to 6 paediatric hospitals in Iraq, worth \pounds 242,000 in total. Supplies includes antibiotics, cancer drugs, surgical items, baby and soya milk, wheelchairs and crutches, operating labels and others.


